

**Nepean Fine Arts League  
Members' Night Exhibition & Sale  
Atrium and Centrepointe Theatre Galleries  
101 Centrepointe Drive, Nepean Ontario**

This show is open to members only. There is no entry fee. Each NFAL member is entitled to exhibit one work only, the overall dimensions of which must not exceed 40"W maximum and 40"H maximum in either direction. All works must have been completed within the last year and must not have won a previous award at any other juried show. Please, no copies, kits or works worked on under instruction or at workshops. The Executive reserves the right to inspect work and to reject artwork deemed unsuitable for a NFAL exhibit.

All entries should be either suitably framed with a sturdy hanging wire or ready for gallery display. A label must be attached to the back or underside of the piece stating the name and phone number of the artist, title and price.

Sales arrangements are to be conducted through the NFAL representative whose name will be displayed with the exhibition gallery list. No work can be removed before takedown as stated in our contract with the City of Ottawa. Bios are displayed with the exhibit lists in the gallery. Entrants are asked to unpack their work and to take home any wrappings.

A waiver must be signed to exhibit. The exhibitor is solely responsible for the insurance of the works of art. The City assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to any of the works while on exhibit, except to the extent loss or damage is caused by the direct negligence of the City. Therefore, **a value must be attached with your application even if the work is not for sale**. Once the exhibition is complete, upon the day of pick-up, the insurance coverage is terminated. Therefore, paintings must be picked up on the closing date.

It is the responsibility of the artist to pick up and sign out the artwork or arrange for someone else to pick it up and sign it out. Neither the league nor the conveners will accept responsibility for artwork not retrieved at this time. If you fail to retrieve your artwork you will forfeit your right to exhibit in the following year's Members' Exhibition.

Any artwork sold is subject to a 15% commission payable to the NVAC Advisory Committee on the last day of the exhibit.

**The 5 categories are:** oils; watercolours; acrylics; other media (includes all framed art of mixed media, pastel, ink, charcoal, photography, fabric art, collage and pencil) and 3-D free standing art, sculpture, carving, fabric art, jewelry, fused glass and pottery.
