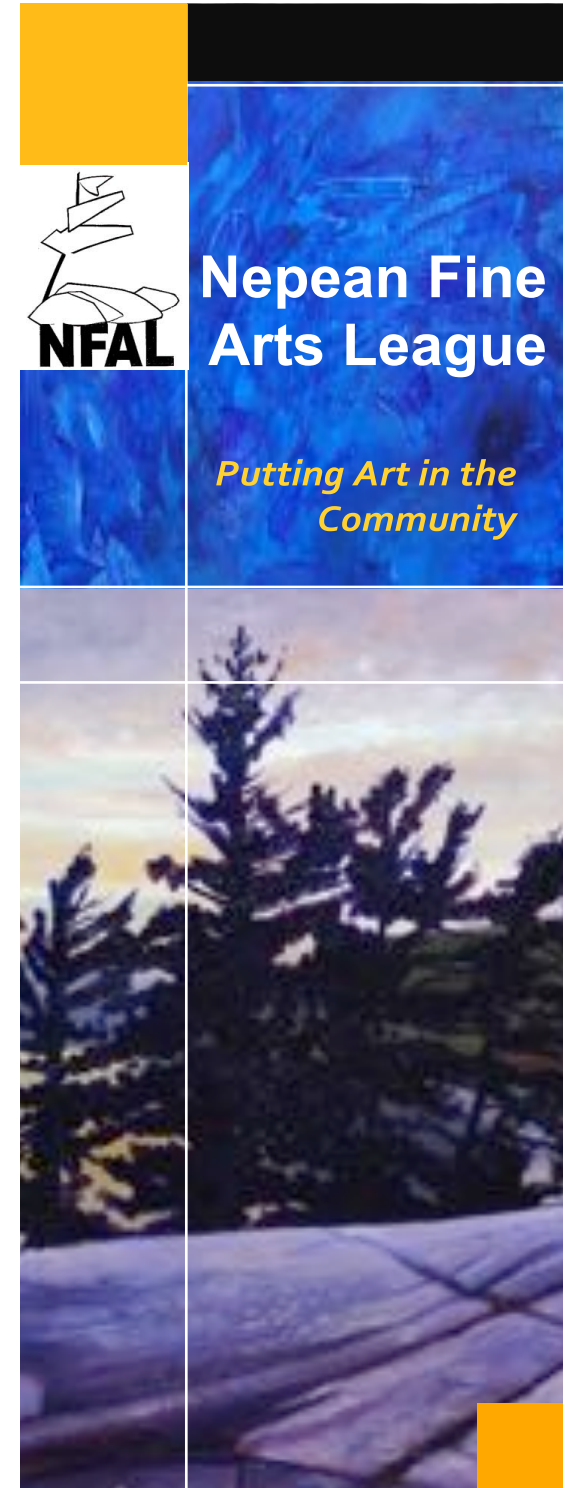
The NFAL Gallery provides an inspiring venue for members to display their artwork, and to foster a broader interest, understanding and celebration of visual arts in the community.

The Nepean Fine Arts League (NFAL) is a dynamic artist run association serving artists in the greater Ottawa-Gatineau region. Founded in 1964 as the Bells Corners Art League, NFAL is one of Ottawa's oldest ongoing arts associations. NFAL encourages and recognizes excellence in the arts across its broadening community.

NFAL promotes visual arts in the community through exhibition and sales, the NFAL Gallery, professional development and networking and social events.

NFAL artists work in diverse media including acrylic, watercolour, oils, mixed media, sculpture, printmaking, and photography.



## The Benefits of Being an NFAL Member

Nepean Fine Arts League has played a pioneering role in community-based artist organizations in Ottawa. It has continually evolved to meet the community's needs and partners with other community art organizations, making the region a dynamic place for emerging, established and recreational visual artists alike.

NFAL's key differentiator is its emphasis on providing its members access to low risk sales opportunities at two annual weekend sales events:

- the Fall/Winter Sale held in November or early December just in time for holiday shopping, and
- the Spring Art Sale held in March or April.

Both feature a Friday Night vernissage open to members and the public.

Other Annual events include the Annual Awards Exhibition and awards event, held in June at Ben Franklin Place and the Annual General Meeting and Social held in September.
